Engine Idling:

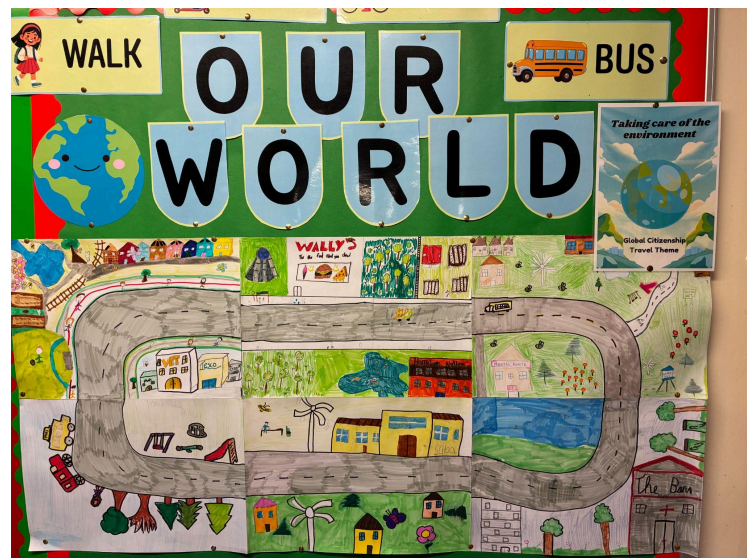
The Green Schools committee has placed a big emphasis on engine idling this year. Engine idling is any time when the car engine is running but the car is not moving eg. waiting at a red light (usually for more than 10-20 seconds). The committee members have raised awareness about engine idling, completed an engine idling survey outside the school and also took part in a workshop facilitated by our Green Schools Travel Officer where they learned about the importance of air quality.



Sustainable Travel:

class carried out an activity with a focus on sustainability and what this might look like in our cities and communities. Some classes even designed, built and presented their own versions of sustainable cities.
